# OVERVIEW

## BASIC MAP OPERATION 11.6 inch screen

### "Info"

Access to "Energy Monitor", "Fuel consumption", "Traffic information", "Weather information" screen.

### "App Suite"

Access to APPS.

### "Phone"

Access to hands-free phone functions.

### "Settings"

Access to the "Setup" screen.

### "Destination"

The "Destination" screen enables to search for a destination (Navigation).

### HOME Button

Press to display the home (Map) screen.

### MENU Button

Press to display the Menu (This) screen.

### VOL Button

Press "▲" or "▼" to adjust the volume.

### AUDIO Button

Press to turn audio system on and off.

### "Display"

Adjust display image and camera image.

Access to Audio Source


### Display the menu

Press the  button or swipe upward.



### Audio control

Press Audio at the bottom of the screen to access audio control functions.



**Hide the menu** Press the  button or Swipe downward.

### 3 shortcuts

The first 3 buttons displayed on the App Suite screen are displayed as shortcuts. App Suite apps can be reordered to customize shortcuts.

## BASIC MAP OPERATION

### 11.6 inch screen

#### Setup

Press  to access "Setup" screen:

- Select to change the selected language, operation sound, keyboard layout settings, etc.
- Select to set the voice settings.
- Select to set Bluetooth® phones and Bluetooth® audio devices.
- Select to set traffic information.
- Select to set memory points (home, preset destinations, address book entries, areas to avoid), navigation details or to delete previous destinations.
- Select to set audio settings.
- Select to set vehicle information.
- Select to set the phone sound, contacts, message settings, etc.
- Select to set Entune App Suite settings.
- Select to set data services settings.

## VOICE RECOGNITION TRAINING AND TUTORIAL

### (6.1 INCH DISPLAY)

Before you begin using the voice recognition system, it is recommended that you access "Train Voice Recognition" and "Voice Recognition Tutorial" in the Setup menu. Voice recognition training is a feature that will help train the voice recognition system to better understand your voice. For best results, it is recommended that voice recognition training be done when there is minimal background noise. The voice recognition tutorial will give an overview of how to use the voice recognition system, including how to make calls and how to customize your experience.





**Quick Tip** – It is recommended that you reduce background noise prior to using the Voice Recognition system. Conversation, high fan speed, wind noise (open windows), etc., may prevent the voice recognition system from understanding your commands.


# TRAFFIC

## MY TRAFFIC ROUTES



Specific routes (such as frequently used routes) on which you wish to receive traffic information can be registered as "My Traffic Routes". A route is set by defining a start point and end point.

## AUTOMATICALLY AVOID TRAFFIC



Select the **Avoid Traffic** option to switch from Manual to Automatic and press **OK**. When heavy traffic is detected during route guidance and a faster route is available, the system will automatically switch to the faster route.
